

## Arkansas Conference Council on Youth Ministry

**Youth Service Fund (YSF)** is a mission fund exclusively of United Methodist Youth. YSF is money raised by youth, spent by youth to benefit youth. For every dollar of YSF money raised, \$.30 goes to the United Methodist Youth Organization where youth from across the US determine grants given to ministries helping youth across the world. The \$.70 that remains in the Arkansas Conference is used 1/3 for Conference youth ministry, 1/3 for In-Conference projects and 1/3 for Out-of-Conference Projects. Our Youth Service Fund Task Force made up of representatives from each district, determine how YSF monies from this Conference are spent, upon the approval of the CCYM.

1. The mission of the United Methodist Church is to make disciples of Jesus Christ, therefore projects will be examined to see how they challenge youth to live as faithful disciples of Jesus Christ.
2. The project must be youth-related. (12-18 years of age)
3. YSF grants should have a substantial effect on the project.
4. YSF grants will not be used to fund a deficit.
5. Projects should be racial/ethnic inclusive whenever possible.
6. Preference will be given to United Methodist projects within the connectional system. Projects of other churches and cooperative efforts between religious groups will be favored next. Finally, projects sponsored by secular organizations that meet CCYM criteria will be considered.
7. Priority will be given to those projects that are youth-led.

### YSF Grants

1. The YSF committee shall meet at the first meeting of the new year (Feb. 21) to finalize YSF requests. All action shall be voted on by the entire body.
2. Grant applicants shall:
  - i. Answer all form questions in full.
  - ii. Provide photographs for YSF promotion and education.
  - iii. Be required to present a photograph and at least 3 personal statements from the youth after the project has been completed.
3. All YSF grant requests must be postmarked no later than December 31 of the year preceding the meeting at which the requests are approved.
